

Changes to the Constitution of the IUSLISAA

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

- “librarianship” is struck and replaced with “the profession”

ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP

- This Article has been significantly altered, dividing Section 1 into two sections, Sections 1 and Section 2. These broaden the terms of membership and include language indicating no dues are required.

ARTICLE IV: OFFICERS

- This Article has been significantly expanded to include Section 3: Responsibilities, as well as clarification of job roles

ARTICLE V: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- This Article has been significantly expanded to include Sections 3: Election, Section 4: Vacancy, Section 5: Representative to Indiana University Alumni Association executive Council and Section 6: Responsibilities. These sections discuss at great length the duties and expectations of a member of the Board of Directors

ARTICLE VI: MEETINGS

- This Article establishes that there will be at least two (2) meetings per year, as opposed to one (1) in the original Consitution

ARTICLE VII: COMMITTEES

- This Article establishes various committees to fulfill the duties required of the IUSLISAA

ARTICLE VIII: VOTING

- This Article gives regulations concerning voting and proxy voting- noting that proxy voting is allowed with a 72 hour notice to the Secretary

ARTICLE XI: AMENDMENTS

- The only change in the Article is the addition of detail as to how amendments should be posted and reviewed before voting occurs.
